- For students that don't have a background in medical terminology or basic human biology, AHMS 144 Medical Terminology and BIOH 104 Basic Human Biology should be taken before or with AHMS 160 and AHMS 162 for best readiness.
- Upon completion of the program, students will be able to sit for the American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC) or American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA) coding exams.
- Students have opportunity to further their education and thus career opportunities after earning the Medical Coding and Insurance Billing certificate. For example, many of the credits in the Medical Coding and Insurance Billing certificate are applicable to the AAS Medical Administrative Assistant degree. Students that earn an AAS degree, can bridge their credits to a Bachelor of Applied Science degree through MSUB.
