V. GUESTS/REPRESENTATIVES

- Ms. Darla Tyler-McSherry: Quarantine and Isolation on campus is at 0. Testing for athletes and symptomatic students, 1000 tests from the beginning to now with 6 positive results. That demonstrates our efforts which are doing well. Friday the 18th & 19th there will be asymptomatic testing available through SHS. Masked tabling with the jacket health ambassadors at the City College tomorrow. Bautista asks what the mask wearing situation will look like for next fall or spring. The response is that it is dependent on the vaccine availability. Incident command will be addressing the hesitancy regarding getting the vaccine as well to inform people about the benefits of the vaccine.

VI. ADVISOR REPORTS

- Dr. Kimberly Hayworth: Fall registration started yesterday. New student registration has currently increased from this time last year. Sneak Peek events today and Friday allowed students to visit classrooms, faculty offices, and essentially give a tour of campus. Chancellor and Vice Chancellor for Administration and Finance will be attending the meeting of March 23rd. New Military and Veteran Success Center Coordinator has been hired. More HyFlex Courses are being offered next semester, marketing the flexibility of courses at MSUB is something that Director of Marketing and Communications and Dr. Hayworth have been working on. Asked the Senators for input about how to achieve this goal. Graduation information has been sent out to graduates and next fall graduation applications are open. Senator Bautista asked for clarification on what HyFlex classes are. Hyflex Classes are available in person when that is convenient for the student but also offers the ability to review recorded lectures after class hours and obtain the information you cannot be present in person. BMG Williams asks whether the faculty are required to have a HyFlex format to accommodate the possible quarantines. There is not a requirement for HyFlex, but the faculty are required to accommodate the quarantine situation the best they can. Dr. Pope mentions that a limiting factor in allowing more HyFlex classes is the technology in classrooms to accommodate the demand for the online format. Dr. Hayworth mentioned that there are roughly 20 classrooms which have been outfitted with improved technology.
