IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – 03/16/2021 motion by Senators Davis and Ferestad; Passes V. GUESTS/REPRESENTATIVES

- Chancellor Hicswa & Vice-Chancellor for Administration & Finance; Susan Simmers
 - Proposed MSUB Tuition, Room, Board & Fee increases for the next biennium, FY22-23.
 - Previous recommendations have been included in the presentation.
 - VC Simmer reviewed the Executive and Process summary with those present.
 - Mainly adressed changes in tuition and course costs.
 - Opened discussion for senator's input -

Pres Unzaga mentions his concern for certain parking fees. Senator Boze asks whether the fee increase for parking lot maintenance will be expected to reduce after the repairs are completed. Not likely to reduce due to the repeated costs of repair. SRO Norris voices her concern with the housing and dining fee increase and anticipates the pushback from students in this increase. VP Cunningham and other senators voice their concerns specifically with the dining experience here and that it detracts from student engagement. Chancellor and VC mention that their costs are not based on quality and advised that the concerns we have mentioned are something that we can have an impact in changing. Dr. Pope suggests that it may be possible for MSUB to take over food services, pending the contract. Also, a possible larger group effort from other campus' in the area to help create a bulk cost to reduce the individual campus cost. **SRO Norris** offers to organize a new meeting to discuss the quality of food with the Sodexo representative. Student Regent Sexton asks for a future inquiry into whether there is a stipulation in the contract about the food quality provided to the students.

- Asks for a resolution to the proposed summary of tuition and fees. Resolution should be completed by next Senate meeting.
 - VP Cunningham made assessment on his concerns in the fees listed within the Student Activity Fee increase and how they did not accurately reflect the issues he was aware of. VC Simmers offers to follow up with the Recreation director about this concern.
- Ms. Darla Tyler-McSherry
 - More changes to vaccine availability. Many appointments are available and are open for any Yellowstone county resident 16 and older.
