• Financial Bill #16: Multicultural Club Trip

That the sum of \$500.00 be allocated from contingency index #630200 to the Multicultural Club to take international students on a trip to Cody, Wyoming.

- Approved
- Financial Bill #17: Study Lounge Renovation

That the sum of \$15,000 be allocated from contingency index #630200 to Housing to renovate the study rooms in the dorms.

- Senators Chenoweth, Imokhai, Bookheimer agreed to give \$10,500 to renovate one to prove that all the rooms will be utilized after renovation they recommend to vote against this bill
- Senator McGraw and Foxley have lived in the dorms and believe the rooms will be used
- o Dr. Hayworth: there is a 40% discount right now to do the rooms
 - Initial request was about \$40,000
 - Received \$10,500 from the equipment fees
- Jorden and Chloe from SAB expressed that students have told her about wanting to update the study lounged
- Only 300 students will really be using the new room
- o Equipment fee meeting: if the one room was a success, then the equipment fees would fund the rest of the requested amount the next year
- People who are paying extra to live on campus deserve to get the new study rooms – other students can use the library and the other campus resources
- o Purpose of ASMSUB: be the largest voice for the student body
- Senator Garayeva- has seen students using the old study rooms as late as 2 am during her rounds
- Business manager: we have a limited budget so by funding this then we would not be able to fund a different contingency request
- Senator Slade: which is more important, improving student life in the dorms or funding club trips
- Long term impact over the course of at least a decade
- o Dr. Gentry commented that she was proud to see a Real debate!
- The more appealing the residence space is, the more students would want to attend our college
- Approved by majority
