**This Week's Opponent:**

Western New Mexico University – Thursday will be the last meeting between WNMU and MSUB as PacWest Conference opponents. Both schools will join the Heartland Conference next year, where they will meet three times. The Mustangs have lost 11 straight with their last win coming on January 18 against Hawaii Pacific. They are currently 6-20 overall and 1-13 in the PacWest after starting the season at 5-5.

Guard Matt Enriquez leads the Mustangs in scoring at 16.5 ppg and is second on the team for rebounding at 4.2 ppg. He missed last week's loss to Grand Canyon with an injury. Forward Mike Sells is adding 15.2 ppg and leads the team with 55 three-pointers. Freshman Trey Clarkson is adding 11.2 ppg and has made 50 threes.

**Last Week's Highlights:**

There was no secret as to what the game plan was for Montana State-Billings this week: shoot 3-pointers. MSU-Billings hoisted up 51 threes Saturday night, knocking down a season-high 19 in a 124-92 win over Johnson & Wales.

The Yellowjackets started the game with back-to-back 3-pointers from Buddy Windy Boy and Carlin Hughes in the first 40 seconds. Behind that 6-2 start, MSU-Billings never trailed in the game.

Justin Hassell was playing his final home game for the Yellowjackets and gave one of the best performances of his career. He scored a career-high 33 points on 10-of-19 shooting from the field. He knocked down 13-of-17 from the free throw line, moving him to No. 10 all time in school history with 274 made free throws. Hassell capped the night with his PacWest leading tenth double-double of the season, grabbing 12 rebounds.

Four Yellowjackets combined for 105 of the team's points. Windy Boy finished the night with 28 points, hitting 8-of-17 from 3-point range. Cameron Munoz added five 3-pointers and Hughes hit four from long range. Munoz finished with 24 points and six assists.

Hughes gave a glimpse of the future for the Yellowjackets. The freshman point guard posted a triple-double with 20 points, 10 rebounds and 16 assists. The 16 assists tied the school single game record held by Jamie Stevens (vs. Concordia, 11/26/98). The last Yellowjacket to record a triple-double was Jerett Skrifvars, who had 24 points, 13 rebounds, and 11 steals against Great Falls (2/5/04).

Off the bench, the Jackets' Drew Arnold scored nine points and grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds. He was 4-of-6 from the floor. Cody Samuelson and Kerington Youmans added five points apiece. Samuelson also had six rebounds.

MSU-Billings hit 17 three-pointers Thursday night to pull away from Montana State-Northern, 94-69. Cameron Munoz and Carlin Hughes made six 3-pointers apiece.

MSU-Billings put together a 12-1 run over the middle four minutes of the second half to break the game open. Buddy Windy Boy's 3-pointer started the run with 12:03 to play, and Justin Hassell's layup at 8:35 put the Jackets up 71-55. MSU-Billings extended its lead to as many as 28 down the stretch.

Munoz, who was 6-of-16 from beyond the arc, moved into second place all-time on the Yellowjacket career 3-point list, passing Mark Hamilton's 286.

Hughes finished with a career-high 29 points, knocking down 6-of-15 from long range. He and Munoz combined for 25 first half points to help the Jackets overcome their sluggish start. Hughes also handed out seven assists.

Four of the five Yellowjacket starters scored in double figures. Hassell finished with 21 points, connecting on 9-of-11 from the free throw line. Windy Boy added 11 points with three 3-pointers.

The Jackets out rebounded the Lights 45-39, including 15 offensive rebounds that led to 14 second chance points. Munoz grabbed eight boards, and Cody Samuelson and Drew Arnold finished with seven apiece. MSU-Billings also forced 14 Lights turnovers that led to 26 points.

### 2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

**Craig Carse (10<sup>th</sup> year):** Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

**Dave Carse (1<sup>st</sup> year):** After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

**Brent Montague (8<sup>th</sup> year):** After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
