Graphic Designer	\$52,170 - \$55,640	\$58,910 x 39 = \$2,297,490
Photographer	\$34,450 - \$40,040	\$40,760 x 39 = \$1,589,640
Fine Artist	\$45,990 - \$57,810	\$59,300 x 39 = \$2,312,700
High School Art Teacher	\$32,620 - \$59,000	\$65,220 x 39 = \$2,543,580

What percentage of Art graduates report having a job after graduating?

Out of the 33% of 2023 Art graduates that we received grad data on, **100% reported being employed* after graduation**.

Overview of the Art program:

Art students at MSUB explore their research interests through developing visual language and critical thinking skills. With small class sizes and easy access to studios, students emerge as professionals boasting solo exhibitions and ready to enter creative fields or seek higher degrees.

Students can focus on their favorite emphasis – whether in Art History, Art Education, or in the Studio with Ceramics, Drawing, Painting, Photography, New Media, or Sculpture!

What makes the Art program unique?

- Low student-to-faculty ratio means students have access to faculty for mentoring and insightful critiques.
- Graduating students leave with a successful solo exhibition on their résumé!
- Study abroad with faculty to Italy and the Venice Biennale!
