Overview of the English program:

By offering a variety of subjects involving literary analysis, advanced writing skills, and fundamental linguistic knowledge, the BA in English prepares students for a wide variety of careers involving close reading, proficient writing, and flexible learning greatly valued by employers in all fields.

The BA in English with the Teaching Licensure Option further prepares majors to teach English at the high school level with the same basic requirements as those for the BA, plus key education courses that provide a crucial combination of theoretical and applied knowledge with practical experience to make them effective educators.

Majors in English have the opportunity to immerse themselves in areas of literature, writing, and linguistics at a far deeper level than they have experienced before.
