What are the average annual wages and potential lifetime earnings for professionals working in the Outdoor Adventure Leadership field?

Occupation	Annual Mean Wage in MT*	Potential Lifetime Earnings*
Outdoor Activities Instructor**	\$42,570 - \$46,740	\$45,330 x 39 yrs = \$1,767,870
Activities / Recreation Worker	\$31,920 - \$33,850	\$34,410 x 39 yrs = \$1,341,990
Outdoor Travel Guide	\$32,620 - \$36,270	\$36,060 x 39 yrs = \$1,406,340
Recreation Manager	\$73,580 - \$77,810	\$73,460 x 39 yrs = \$2,864,940
Lifeguard / Ski Patrol / Recreational Protective Service Worker	\$29,000 - \$32,460	\$30,380 x 39 yrs = \$1,184,820

What percentage of Outdoor Adventure Leadership graduates report having a job after graduating?

Out of the 33% of 2021 Outdoor Adventure Leadership graduates that we received graduate data on, 100% reported being employed* after graduation.
