



Wi-Fi Service

Hard wired and wireless high speed internet service in each room along with the common areas on the floors and the main lobby.

Computer Lab

Each residence hall has a computer lab with free printing and a dedicated space for studying.

Use your U-Card or quarters to use washing machines and dryers located on each floor. Vending machines can also be found in each laundry room.

Lounge Area

Rooms are furnished with an adjustable bed that lifts 33% inches off the ground for prime storage space.

Ice Machines

Ice machines available in the main lobbies of each hall.

Parking

Parking available to students with easy and quick access to each residence hall.

Housing During Breaks

Housing during the winter and summer breaks is available to students. Though residence halls officially close during those times, students can stay for a fee. The Residence Halls remain open during Thanksgiving and Spring Breaks at no additional costs. Dining Services has limited options during all breaks.

Entertainment


MSUB students receive free entry into our student activities and events including concerts, comedians, and other live entertainment, sporting events, and art exhibits.

We have a wide range of student organizations and clubs which include academics, arts, supportive services, student government, culture & religion, recreation, and more.






Look up your NetID and set your password.

Sign-in to the housing portal with your MSUB email as your username and NetId password to complete the housing application.



During your designated timeslot chose your room and meal plan. Pay a \$125 deposit














Arrival:

Under your F-1 student visa, you may enter the U.S. up to 30 days before the program start date listed on your I-20 – August 27, 2025. The earliest date you can arrive is July 28.

Flights to Billings should arrive between:

Saturday, August 23 – Tuesday, August 26

Billings Logan Airport

Upload your flight itinerary to the International Student Confirmation Form. MSU Billings offers airport pickup for students who inform us of their arrival 1 week in advance.

If any issues arise such as flight delays or cancellations please let us know via WhatsApp.

Arrival to Billings



In the online International Student Confirmation form, please upload a copy of your flight itinerary. We MUST receive this at least a week prior to your departure.

We will arrange for someone from our office to pick you up from the airport. They will meet you in baggage claim and will be holding a sign that says "Welcome MSUB International Student!".

Next, you will get checked in to your dorm room where an international student will be available to help you get settled and answer any questions you may have.

You will receive a welcome bag with some essentials and campus information.

*Please note that there will be no blanket/sheets/pillows on your bed. You can order them ahead of time or bring a set along with you.

The international student orientation leaders will be available to answer any of your questions.





Students who are interested in participating in this program should complete the Billings Friendship Family Questionnaire.

The Billings Friendship Family (BFF) program matches international students with a local family based upon shared interests and personalities.

Typically, the BFF will pick up their student from the airport and help them get settled in the dorms and life in Billings, MT.

Over the course of the semester, BFF families will have their students over for dinner, invite them to local attractions or even host them during holiday breaks.


This is a great opportunity for students to experience American culture.
