ARTH 494: Contemporary Practices: Venice Biennale and Renaissance Art History



Experience the art from the Renaissance in Florence to Contemporary times at the Venice Biennale and explore how artists' studio practices respond to our everchanging world.

This study abroad learning experience will be connected to Advanced Studio Workshop: ARTZ 494 for 1 credit. It will be open to all MSUB students who are currently enrolled or who express an interest in the subject matter. This learning experience will be primarily focused on visiting sites of art and culture with the intention to better interpret global visual communication.

Learning Objectives: Students will

- 1. Collect information on art and artists and identify trending themes in the Venice Biennale.
- 2. Converse together to examine and analyze contemporary art in the Venice Biennale during multiple group dinners.
- 3. Draw connections between the art/architecture of the Renaissance Art History of Florence, Italy, and contemporary art at the Venice Biennale to locate their own studio practice in art history.
- 4. Navigate international locations and cultures by practicing various wayfinding and immersion techniques.



Meals and Free time

- The daily itinerary will start with breakfast at the hotel followed by group attendance at the art or cultural institution scheduled.
- Be prepared to purchase your own lunch. At the Biennale, the only onsite food option is a café with various menu items including salads, sandwiches, desserts, coffee and other beverages.
- Typically, in the mid-late afternoon there will be open time for students to do self-exploration, shopping, or visit other entities not required for the group. If there is a group dinner planned, a meeting time and place will be established and announced in the morning. Group dinners will be scheduled for late evening around 8 pm (as per the Italian culture.)
