The Dead Did Get It: Reporters and Cops

"That's what you get for dealing the killer news," laughed state attorney Jerry Van Buren at the 11 members of the Grand Jury brought to and his agents had searched up into the Dead's kitchen.

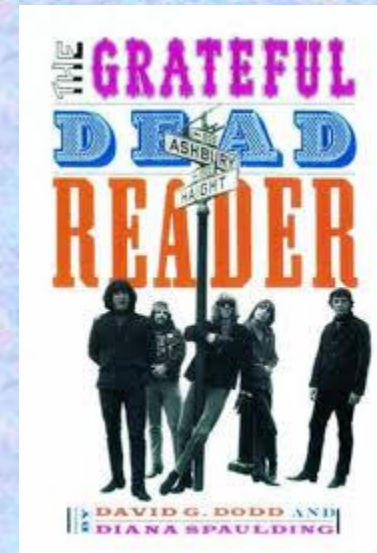
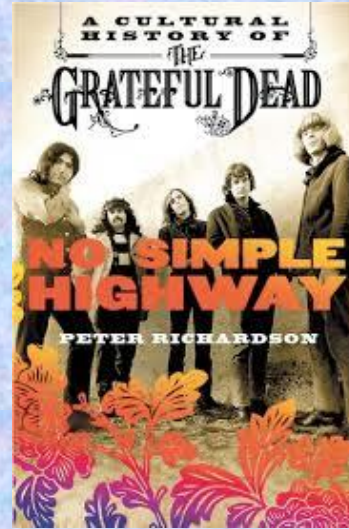
