Sharon Hobbs, Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. in the Chancellor's Conference Room.

The November 30 and December 14 meeting minutes were accepted as presented.

I. ITEMS – FIRST READING

Item 41 REC courses. Change course descriptions to remove fee references.

Item 41.a REC courses. Change course descriptions to remove references to meeting off campus.

Item 41.b REC courses. Add prerequisite (instructor approval).

The Committee agreed Items 41 though 41.b will go to the Senate as consent items.

Item 46 BSEd Secondary Education/Special Education (P-12) Double Major. Modification to an existing program.

Item 46.a BSEd Secondary Education/Reading Double Major 5-12 and K-12 Reading Endorsement. Modification to an existing program.

It was noted that, for the new course, the corequisite is listed as ARTZ 108 Visual Language-3-D Foundations, but really, anyone should be able to take ARTZ 104. The corequisite was removed, and the Committee requested that a change course form be done for ARTZ 108 to add ARTZ 104 as a corequisite.

Steve Coffman, Chair of Communication & Theatre, noted some of the deleted courses are obsolete because the content has been added to other courses. The theatre programs are going away because theatre is on moratorium, soon to be deleted. The FILM rubric is problematic (it was a result of Common Course Numbering) since we do not have a film program. Also, the idea of "video production" is now obsolete and new media has taken its place. The minor is being deleted because the state no longer offers this endorsement and it cannot be accredited.

Item 25.a BA Major in Communication Arts Organizational Communication Option. Modification to an existing program.

Item 25.b BS Major in Public Relations. Modification to an existing program.

Item 25.c Minor in Communication Arts Organizational Communication Option. Modification to an existing program.

Item 25.d Minor in Communication Arts Mass Communication Option. Modification to an existing program, including title change to Media Studies Option.

Item 25.e Teaching Minor in Speech Communication. Delete existing program.

- Motion by Jennifer Scroggins, seconded by Joseph Bryan to **approve Items 25** through 25.e on first reading.

Dr. Coffman noted that the term "mass communication" refers to radio, television, and newspapers, which are one-way communication. Nationally, the discipline has changed to "media studies" terminology since contemporary communication is highly interactive.

It was noted that COMX 430 Advertising, Media, and Culture was deleted in the previous items, but still appears in the revised versions of these programs. These will be revised for second reading. It was also noted that a title change for COMX 330 Principles of Mass Communication has not yet been done. The Committee requested that this form be submitted as soon as possible.

It was cited that the changes in the Minor in Communication Arts Organizational Communication Option (Item 25.c) create issues with prerequisites. Dr. Coffman agreed to withdraw Item 25.c and leave the minor as is.

- The motion to approve was withdrawn.
- Motion by Brian Gurney, seconded by Joseph Bryan to approve Items 25, 25.a, 25.b, 25.d, and 25.e on first reading.
- Motion carried.

Second reading will be held when the revised and additional paperwork have been submitted.
