Further, we just changed the name of the former Native American Studies Minor to American Indian and Indigenous Studies Minor. Dr. Pierce noted that most artists in the field use "First Nations." It was suggested that, like the American Indian and Indigenous Studies Minor, Dr. Pierce could work with the Native American Achievement Center and the AllNations Club to choose terminology that the University community uses.

It was also noted that the title of this course is very long, and thus it is heavily abbreviated. Will a student be able to decipher what all of the abbreviations mean?
