## Be Active With TRIO Advocates

The TRIO Advocates Club will be ending the school year with two events for all MSUB students to participate in.

TRIO Advocates will be holding a Cornhole Tournament on Monday, April 22nd at 3PM on the lawn in front of the Student Union Building. The tournament will be a part of "Be a Hero Week" - a week of events for students to de-stress and be engaged in campus activities.



Cornhole is a game where participants take turns throwing bean bags into the hole of an inclined wooden plank. Players toss the bean bags from the pitchers box, which is directly to the right and the left of the wooden platform. Any player who steps out of the pitchers box during their turn receives a foul. The first team to earn 21 points wins.

The winning team will win a \$100 and \$60 gift certificates for a tattoo. If you want to participate in the tournament, show up around 2:45PM and sign up. 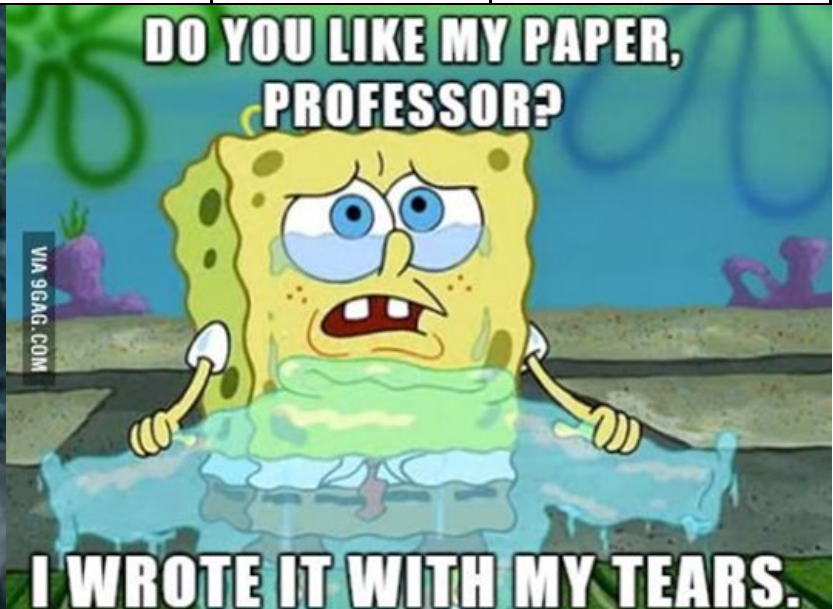
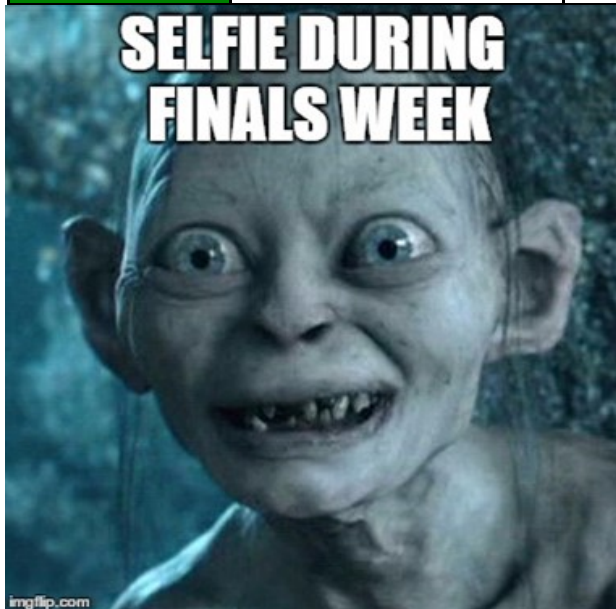
